



ROMA HISTORICAL MOTOR CLUB INC. – SIVS INFORMATION SHEET

PLACING YOUR VEHICLE ON THE SPECIAL INTEREST VEHICLE SCHEME – RESTRICTED REGISTRATION

1. Please ensure you are financial with the club - Your current membership card (or if you can't find it, your receipt of payment of fees) is proof of membership.
2. Take this proof of membership and your vehicle to your nearest dating officer. Please contact Ken on 0429 452 286, if you live too far away from our dating officers. Geographical distance is a legitimate reason to do dating with photos and registration/VIN/Chassis information. He will process via phone, email or post for you once the photos and information and proof of membership is provided.
3. The dating officer will sight your club membership (or contact the club admin if you don't have any proof with you). They will make sure the form is completed correctly and sign that you are a financial member of the club and that your vehicle's age is 30 years or more.
4. You will sign that you are and will remain a member of an incorporated vehicle club in Qld.
5. You will then take the completed dating certificate to the Department of Transport and Main Roads and complete their paperwork.
6. Check that your CTP is correct. DTMR officers are more familiar with these now, but just in case check the following:
The sections on your registration should read
CTP CLASS 5.
Purpose of Use - PRIVATE
Concession Type - SPECIAL INTEREST VEHICLE.

In cases of the incorrect amount (higher amount) being charged, it is most likely the CTP class will still be CLASS 1. The total amount should be around \$240.

If you are intending to drive your vehicle for everyday use, it should not be put on SIVS registration.

Club members are also encouraged to support club events in the first instance.*
